**Rules:**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), US Sailing Rules, and MAYRA Rules. All boats must have official class numbers prominently displayed on both sides of their sails. US Coast Guard approved lifejackets must be worn by all sailors. All boats must carry 25ft. of towline.

**Notes:**

- Three minute dinghy start sequence will be used.
- There will be a minimum of (2) races for each class, conditions permitting.
- The races will be held in the Great Sound, which is about a 45 minute sail from the club depending on conditions. Patrol boats may be available to tow sailors out but a tow can not be guaranteed.
- Course information and local rules to be provided at skipper's meeting or upon request.
- Cost is \$25.00 per Skipper, \$10.00 per Crew.
- Pre Registration is available by mailing in the attached form and payment. All pre registration forms

must be received by July 15<sup>th</sup>.
